From our Pastor
Let's Talk about Love

The month of February gives spotlight to the topic of love. If you’ve noticed, stores are displaying candies and cards. Valentine’s Day gives attention to cupids, hearts, pink, and red. Spouses normally share romantic dates and schoolchildren exchange colorful cards. February could be regarded as the month of love. As many stop to think about their significant others on February 14, let’s remember the place and prominence of love in the Christian life. To do so, let’s consider four realities.



Love is from God. We can’t know real love apart from Him. John highlighted this reality in 1 John 4:8. All talk of love is second-rate at best, if it isn’t grounded in the knowledge of the Lord. The world often barter with a love that is based on reciprocity – you love me and I’ll love you. Christian love comes from God; therefore, it is unconditional and sacrificial.

Love is the Greatest Command. Other religions maintain that one must follow a creed or a code of ethics in order to please God. Jesus taught that we fulfill God’s Law by directing our heart to love Him and others (Exodus 20:1-17; Matthew 22:37-40). While there are many important virtues, love is “the greatest of these” (1 Corinthians 13:13). To live a life that honors God and helps others, make selfless love your pursuit and priority (Matthew 7:12, 22:37-40).

We love because of God. Our human nature is completely unable to emulate the love of God. Fortunately, believers have help. The Spirit of God can empower their hearts to love like God (Romans 5:5; Galatians 5:22).

Love can shine the light of God. When we love with the love that comes from God’s Spirit, others will notice a difference in our lives (John 13:35). Many will be convinced of the truth of Christ and be compelled to worship Him as well (Matthew 5:16). Let’s make love our aim!
