# From our Pastor Mission Month

March 2022 is a month we dedicate to missions. Our first short term trip of the year — Bassmaster Classic — will take place the first week of the month, and our annual Mission Banquet will return on March 31. What an exciting month! As we seek to be faithful to Christ's call, let's remember the biblical basis for what we do in this area.

**Humanity's Purpose** At the beginning of time, God created the first man and woman. He made those two in His own image (Genesis 1:26-27). That means they were made to know God (John 17:3) and enjoy His abundant life (John 10:10). Unfortunately, sin and rebellion brought cataclysmic results to the human condition.



**God's Plan** Even before humanity's first sin, God ordained His Son as ransom payment for sin (Romans 5:8; Revelation 13:8). His plan involved the birth of Jesus through a woman (Genesis 3:15; Galatians 4:4). The nation of Israel was His chosen means of delivering humanity's deliverer (Genesis 12:1-3). When He placed Israel in Canaan, He situated them in the middle of all other nations, signifying the way Messiah would provide salvation for all peoples.

**The Church's Mission** We now live in an era of human history Jesus called "the times of the Gentiles" (Luke 21:24). During this epoch, God is securing a people for Himself from all nations. It is His will for His people to proclaim His gospel message to all people (Mark 16:15). We are under divine mandate to take the gospel across the streets, across the states, and across the seas!

The Eternal State Because of what Jesus has done, the New Heaven and New Earth will be filled with "a vast multitude from every nation, tribe, people, and language, which no one could number, standing before the throne and before the Lamb" (Revelation 7:9).
