From our Pastor

Easter Sunday

Easter Sunday is coming! On April 17, we will gather at 10 am for worship at Cartersville High School football stadium. Meeting at Weinman Stadium will provide us with two opportunities. First, it will allow us to all meet together. Being in one service is important on such a special Sunday. Second, meeting in a public place will provide us greater opportunity to invite others.



As we prepare for worship on Resurrection Sunday, let me encourage you to prepare for this special day by inviting others. Not long ago, Lifeway Research polled Americans and asked when they were most open to consider matters of faith. The top five responses included the Christmas season, Easter Sunday, after a national catastrophe such as 9/11, after a natural disaster such as a hurricane or tornado, and after the birth of a baby. According to Lifeway's research, Easter presents a great opportunity to invite others to church! Let me share a few ideas concerning how you might invite others to Easter worship.

Handout invite cards. We have made invitation cards available at the church on Sunday mornings. Take a few bundles. Hand out invites in drive-thru lines, at restaurants, to check-out clerks, and elsewhere. I've discovered most people are cordial and receptive to an invite.

Post on social media. Leading up to Easter, make a post or two inviting people to Resurrection worship. Although there is a lot of negative stuff on the internet, we can use it to make an impact for Christ.

Give a gift. Perhaps you could bake some Easter goodies for your neighbor. Deliver a plate of treats with invites to Easter Sunday. Laura and I have done this in the past, and we have found it is a well-received gesture.

As you spread the word about Easter Sunday, pray that the Lord would draw people to worship!

Parent Like God

When our staff planned our 2022 calendar several months ago, we desired to put a couple sermon series on the church calendar that could be used in a special way to reach out and minister to people. After some discussion, we felt it would be good to have one such series immediately after Easter Sunday. The idea was simple — a lot of visitors will attend on Easter Sunday. In inviting them to a sermon series that evokes some interest, we may be more likely to see visitors return to church.

With these things in mind, the staff felt a parenting series may touch on a need. Parenting is one of the greatest blessings in life, but it can sometimes seem like a daunting, and even impossible, task. Countless voices offer endless advice. Sometimes it's easy to feel overwhelmed. Who should we listen to? What should we believe? The onslaught of books, podcasts, and professionals offering expert opinions can make parenting feel way too complicated, not to mention all of the free advice on social media. At times, we can feel ill-prepared. In the midst of so many unrealistic expectations, can God's Word give any clarity?

Fortunately, the Lord has given us a simple metaphor in Scripture that provides light and insight. The Bible often speaks of our Lord as our "Heavenly Father." That simple title tells us a lot about God, but it also tells us a lot about parenting. It reveals that healthy parenting starts with a healthy understanding of how our Heavenly Father relates to us. In a sermon series entitled "Parent Like God," we will examine four foundations for godly parenting that all come from the way God relates to us:

Love — God loves us, so loving our children is a hallmark of godly parenting.

Relationship — God relates to us, so having a healthy relationship with our children is a foundation of godly parenting.

Instruction — God teaches us and trains us through His Word, so training and instruction are integral parts of godly parenting.

Correction — Sometimes God has to correct us, so correction and discipline are often necessary for godly parenting.

This sermon series will take place April 24-May 22. I hope you will prepare to be present on Sunday mornings for this important sermon series. If you know of parents, guardians, or grandparents who may benefit from this study, please feel free to invite them. If some are unable to attend or uncomfortable to do so, you can encourage them to keep up with the study through our podcast, television broadcast, or live-streaming channels.

Video Production

Director

- Calls video shots and communicate with switcher operator to take camera and/or graphic feeds to live.
- Must have a knowledge of each of the video production roles. Must be able to keep an eye on multiple camera feeds and determine which one to go with during a broadcast.
- Being technically-minded/computer literate is a plus.

Manned Camera Operator

- Operates camera for Sunday morning services and occasionally other special events.
- Great for photographers or people who have a good eye.

Remote Camera Operator - great for beginners

- Operates remote cameras for Sunday morning services and occasionally other special events.
- Great for photographers or people who have a good eye.

Switcher Operator

- Operates video switcher for Sunday morning services and occasionally other special events.
- Great listening skills and able to think and act quickly.

Graphics/Video Playback - Studio and Worship Center

- Operates computers and video equipment during Sunday morning services and occasionally other special events.
- Computer literate, focused, and have attention to detail.

Sound

Worship Center Operator

- Operate sound mixer for live worship services.
- Coordinate with Worship Pastor to have microphones ready for Worship Teams.
- General knowledge of sound mixers and microphones.
- Strong focus and ability to adapt to sound/orchestration changes.

Studio Operator - great for beginners

- Operate sound mixer for broadcasted worship services.
- General knowledge of sound mixers and microphones.
- Strong focus and ability to adapt to sound/orchestration changes.

Lighting

Lighting Operator - great for beginners

- Chooses lighting scenes during worship services.
- Matches color scenes with the backgrounds on our screens for lyric projection.
- Knowledge of DMX and lighting is a plus.
