In Colossians 3:18-21, we find three truths related to the family...

- 1. Wives should respect the spiritual leadership of their husbands (v. 18).
- 2. Husbands are to <u>love</u> their wives (v. 19).

In English, the word love can be used in multiple and varied ways, from superficial infatuation or lust to mere affection to enthusiasm or devotion. We also use the word love in abiding and self-sacrificial ways, as in 'I love my spouse'...Love of this kind, when genuine, is a willful decision that will be demonstrated by conscious acts."
